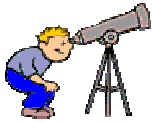

~ Details You Need To Know ~



To All Science Fair Entrants:

Thanks for participating in the Science Fair! I hope you have completed, or are in the process of finishing, your project. **Please take care to include your name, grade and room number somewhere on the front of your display board.** You want people to know immediately who the brilliant student is who did the project! If possible, avoid writing or drawing directly on the board – it's there to hold what you've written and/or drawn, photos and other "stuff". Mount such "stuff" on poster board, if possible, and then attach it to the display board.

Set up for the Science Fair is from 2:00 PM – 6:00 PM on Wednesday, March 19th. (Please note this is a different schedule than in years past.) Bring all your project parts to the Multi-use Room and you will be assigned a spot with your classmates. Please remember that no live animals (like rabbits, buffalo or boa constrictors) are allowed as part of your display. If you need electricity to work with I trust you have already indicated that on your entry form, as well as if you need an extra large space to wheel in a life-size model of the Mars Rover, for instance. If you have NOT indicated this to me already please do so as soon as possible. Oh, and NO OPEN FLAMES or hazardous substances in the MU Room!

Science Fair Evening Schedule: 7:00 – 7:30 -- The Science Fair begins promptly at 7:00 PM. As a participant you **MUST** be stationed at your project until one of our world-renowned "questioners" (Look for smart-looking people in bright yellow hats!) has visited with you to review your project and give you some very cool items. **7:30 – 9:00** – Everyone is encouraged to visit all the other projects.

Please make sure your project is in order before you leave for the evening. All displays will remain set up for classroom tours until the end of the school day on Thursday, March 20th, after which, they should be taken home. Participants who are unable to take their projects that day should contact me to make other arrangements. **Projects unclaimed by Friday, March 21st, will be donated to the BV Science Lab.**
